### Literacy

Monday - This week our Book of the Week is 'Superworm' by Julia Donaldson. Listen to the story here:

Tuesday - In the book 'Superworm' there are many minibeasts! Have a go at writing the following names: 'slug', 'frog', 'bug', 'fly', 'bee'. Remember to use your 'Fred Talk' to help you.

Wednesday - Think about what a ladybird looks like. Ask your grown up to show you a picture of one if you are not sure. Have a go at thinking of some adjectives to describe a ladybird. Write two sentences which include your adjectives, for example, 'It is red. It has six legs.' Remember to use the Magic 5!

Thursday - Read back the sentences that you wrote yesterday. Draw a picture of a ladybird that matches your description.

Friday - Practice your letter formation by thinking of and writing some words that use the letters: 'o', 'd', 'g', 'i', 's', 'c', 'a', 'k'.
