
### **Harvest**




Unfortunately, we have seen an increase in the number of children arriving late and therefore via the main office each day. We appreciate and understand that this can occur on occasions but are currently monitoring this as you may be aware.

The impact of punctuality has a wider impact than may be initially appreciated. Children often do not feel comfortable entering their classroom once learning has begun and their daily routine is interrupted, learning is missed resulting in uncertainty of expectations until this can be addressed by staff, staff are taken away from the office as they are required to support children through school to their classrooms, and missed lunch orders to name a few points.
